A Place Where Honor Lives Kansas Veterans' Home Dedicated to the Service of Veterans

To qualify for admission, veterans must have served active military service for the United States during any period of war, or who served in the active military during peacetime and is entitled to Veterans Affairs hospitalization or domiciliary care under title 38 of the United States code and federal VA rules and regulations, and who has been discharged or relieved from duty under conditions other than dishonorable, who may be disabled by disease, wounds, old age or otherwise disabled, and who, by reason of such disability, is incapacitated from earning a living.

- On a space available basis, the KVH may provide care to eligible spouses, surviving spouses, and Gold Star Parents.
- Possible VA funds awarded to cover the cost of care based upon service-connected disability benefits.
- State veterans homes are required to protect up to \$98 per month for veteran personal comfort money vs. Medicaid "protected income" total of \$62 per month.
- Medicare Part A and Part B therapy services offered.
- Rates can be adjusted for the ability to acquire secondary medical insurance and comfort money.
- A Veteran Service Representative office is onsite to assist with VA claims and benefits questions.
